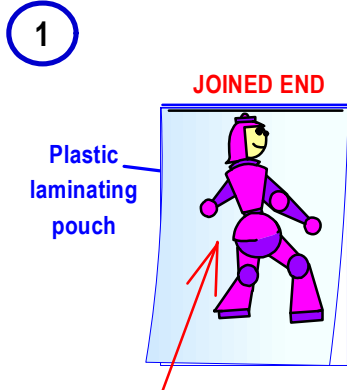


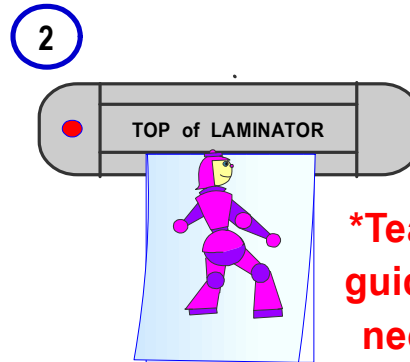
Plastic Laminating

How to (Plastic) Laminate your Printout Top

If you do not have a laminator, borrow one from your resource centre or ask them to do the following for you.

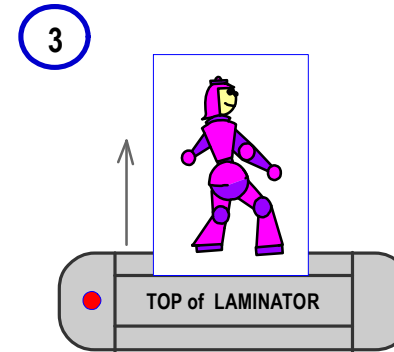


(1) Carefully insert your paper shape into the top end of the laminating pouch.

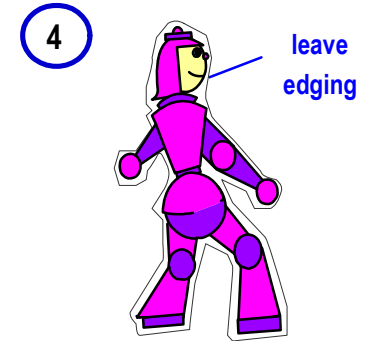


(2) Turn on laminator - When hot enough insert your pouch (light comes on).

***Teacher guidance needed**



(3) When it has gone through let it cool then remove



(4) Cut out shape
The shape is stronger if a few clear edge is left round the shape when trimmed with scissors or snips

Teacher guidance - Beware laminating machines can jam up
TIPS

- 1) Always push paper or card shape right up to the top of the pouch
- 2) 250 micron thick pouches are best if students are to use it.
- 3) It is best to train a student up then they do it for the group .

Buying

Buy one with a quick release lever.
